**SUBJECT: REGARDING REQUEST OF SCHOOL FOR ENHANCEMENT OF SECTIONS - REG.**

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application No.-IS-01053-2526 dt. on the subject cited above.

Sl. No.	GENERAL CONDITIONS
1.	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 74 (As per prescribed dimension) as per the number of class rooms reported during inspection and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.
2.	Compliance of the points no. 1 to 8 may be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal, failing which due action will be taken.
Sl. No.	CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE
1	Initially, school has uploaded document dated NIL against land certificate submitting clarification regarding the status of land on which the school is situated by stating the legal case pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi; therefore, school was asked to upload land certificate STRICTLY as per Annexure-B of SARAS 5.0 Manual. In response of which, school has uploaded document dated 27.07.2024 request for intervention to enable the school to increase the section strength. Hence, on the basis of this document and subject to the final decision in legal case no.CS (OS) No.991 of 2009 titled as DK Modi vs YK Modi & Ors. the application for section is hereby approved. Further, school is required to upload land certificate STRICTLY as per Annexure-B of SARAS 5.0 Manual, issued by DM/ ADM/ SDM/ Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar/ Registrar/ Sub Registrar/ Equivalent Land Authority, clearly depicting the details of actual owner(s) of the land (who owned the land by way of Sale Deed/Gift Deed etc.) and had further, leased the land to Society/Trust running the school.
2	As per the recommendation of NEP, the school shall ensure the participation of its students in the Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning(SAFAL), an exam conducted by the Board every year. This exam, designed to assess and enhance students' learning, is a valuable initiative for their holistic development, as per the guidelines issued by the Board vide circular no: Acad-49/2024 dated 26 June 2024.
3	The school will ensure the Holistic Progress Card (HPC) is used for the foundational stage according to the guidelines issued by the Board via notification no. CBSE/Director (Acad.-Assessment)/2023 dated 27.12.2023.
4	The school shall ensure that all teachers undergo at least 50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) every year, vide notification no. 16/2021 dated 24.09.2023, out of which 25 hours should be from respective COE.
5	The school shall submit an undertaking to upload all requisite information regarding students, teachers, and infrastructure details available in the school on the UDISE and OASIS Portals. The registration of the students in classes IX and XI shall be conditional on the school providing complete information on the UDISE and OASIS Portals.
6	School shall ensure size of all class rooms (sections) running should be as per Board norms i.e. each class room should be of size 500 sq ft.

7	School shall ensure section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 excluding principal, physical education teacher and counsellor, to teach various subjects and appoint qualified trained teaching staff on regular basis as per the provisions laid down in Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2018.
8	The school is directed to ensure that all essential valid documents are available under the head Mandatory Public Disclosure (as per annexure – IX) on school's website at all time and the link of certificates should be remain functional and submit an undertaking in this regard on its letter head duly signed by the principal and manager of the school in the compliance within 03 months.

In this connection, I am directed to convey approval of the Board to permit increase of sections in the school and subject to strict adherence to the other provisions of Affiliation and Examination Bye-Laws of the Board & appendix V of Affiliation Bye-Laws as well as the following specific conditions:

1. The school is permitted to run (74) total number of sections. In case of Senior Secondary level 1/3rd of the total sections permitted can be run in Class XI & XII.
2. The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded by the school online. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
3. The school is required to renew Water & Health Sanitation, Building Safety and Fire Safety certificates on regular basis.
4. The school will ensure adequate teaching staff and other physical facilities in the school for the smooth functioning with its enrolment.
5. The school will adhere to Rule 14.12 of Affiliation Bye laws of the Board and maintain optimum strength of 40 students in a section.
6. This approval will be subject to final outcome of any legal case/ litigation and any other issues arising out of shifting of school or otherwise and CBSE shall not be responsible for any dispute/legal issue arising out of increase in sections.
7. The Board reserves the right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

**“The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate, Building safety certificate and Water and Sanitation Certificate alongwith other essential documents during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms”.**
